




Bill Belichick press conference, September 24, 2001, six days before Brady's first career start, against the Indianapolis Colts:

"I really don't think that I'm going be standing here week after week talking about all the problems Tom Brady had. I have confidence in him, I think the team has confidence in him, I think he'll prepare himself and go out there and perform at a good level. I'm sure that, like every other young player, there will be something in the game you'd like to be done differently. But he'll perform overall in the framework of the offense that we've designed for him and he'll make plays that he's capable of making. That's what my expectations are, and Tom will work hard to respond to that opportunity."






